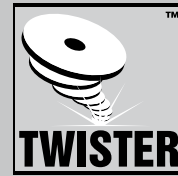


HTC Twister™ Method description



Instructions for stone floors

See overleaf for a detailed pad guide and floor types.

If the floor in question already has a fine and clean surface, upgrading is not necessary. Just introduce the green Twister pad, together with water, into the daily cleaning. In this way, the floor will stay clean and the gloss will increase over time.

If the stone floor in question is matt and dirty, we recommend the following upgrading process based on the standard method, or intensive method, which is described overleaf;

Step 0 - Red pad. Used prior to step 1 for extremely dirty/worn floors for a quick result. "Resets" the floor, leaving a clean matt surface after itself.



Step 1 - White pad. Cleans deep and removes minor scratches.



Step 2 - Yellow pad. Prepares the floor surface for the last and daily step - Step 3.



Step 3 - Green pad. Creates a fine and dirt-resistant surface, which is preserved through the daily use of the green pad.



Dry polish - Dry polishing with a High Speed machine and a green Twister pad is carried out, when you desire an extra high gloss or on surfaces that are not subjected to machine scrubbing during the daily cleaning. This process creates an extra fine and dirt-resistant surface and a result that lasts longer.

If the floor in question has a fine and clean surface, upgrading is not necessary. Just introduce the green Twister pad, together with water, into the daily cleaning. In this way, the floor will stay clean and the gloss will increase over time.

If the floor in question is dirty and worn, we recommend the following upgrading process based on the intensive method described overleaf;

Step 1 - White pad. Cleans deep and removes minor scratches.



Step 2 - Yellow pad. Prepares the floor surface for the last and daily step - Step 3.



Step 3 - Green pad. Creates a fine and dirt-resistant surface, which is preserved through the daily use of the green pad.



Alternative method for quick upgrading of vinyl flooring.

Step 1 - Red pad. Cleans deep and removes minor scratches.



Dry polish - Dry polishing with a High Speed machine and a green Twister pad creates an extra fine and dirt-resistant surface, which provides the best imaginable conditions for continued cleaning with green Twister™.



The upgrading processes described above are a one-off event, if the subsequent continuous/daily cleaning is performed with a green Twister pad. The daily use of the green Twister pad preserves the upgrading effort and the floor remains clean and keeps its lustre over time.

Methods for upgrading / cleaning

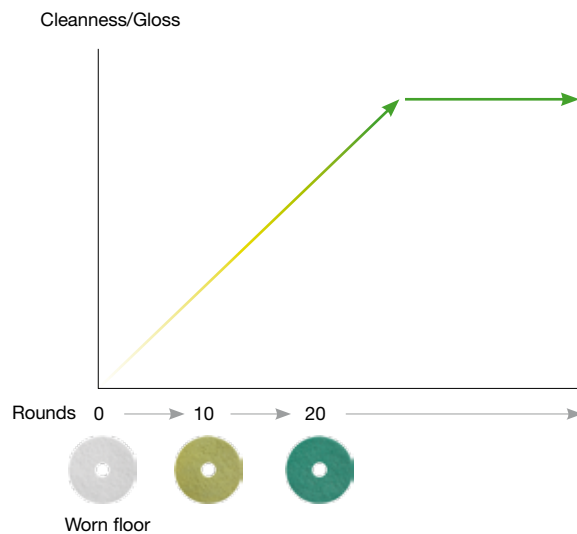
Standard method for upgrading/cleaning

Suitable for larger areas where scrubbing machines are used in the regular cleaning. Carried out as part of the ordinary cleaning procedure without extra efforts. 20 days per step are recommended.









Intensive method for upgrading/cleaning

Suitable, if you desire a quick result, or for smaller areas where scrubbing machines are not used on a daily basis. Upgrading/cleaning is carried out on a single occasion. We recommend that you go over the same area 10 times per step.
